Marijuana Moratorium

Mayor Mockus said she would like Council to consider placing a moratorium on allowing recreational marijuana distributors in the Village of Hebron until the Village has had time to do some research and see how the state is interpreting the law that was just passed, and what other communities are doing. She said to place a moratorium, Council would need to ask for legislation to be drafted. Mrs. Chapman asked if we've seen any feedback from Etna. Mayor Mockus said she thinks it was Newark that introduced a moratorium. Mrs. Chapman said she believes Etna didn't want a dispensary at all. Mayor Mockus said she believes this could built into Hebron's zoning code. She said she spoke to Chief Brooks to make sure he didn't see any concerns. She said he talked about enforcement from the direction of the state level, but he thought this might be a reasonable approach to take. Mr. Wolf said there is currently an opening on the Economic Development Committee and wondered if Council may want to wait until the vacant Council seat is filled. Mayor

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Mockus said she planned to ask Council if they would support moving Mrs. Stoner from the Public Works Committee to the Economic Development Committee, to have plenty of representation, knowledge, and multiple sets of eyes looking at everything as the Village moves forward. These items will be moved to the next Council Meeting agenda.

Mrs. Porter briefly discussed concerns about a candidate request for accommodation in applying for the vacant Council seat. Mayor Mockus read a text from the interested candidate. There was some discussion about the parameters for scheduling interviews for the vacant position.


