ORDINANCE 01-24

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE CURRENT PAY RATE BY FIVE PERCENT 5% FOR ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON, TO AMEND CONTRARY AND INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES BY REPEALING AND AMENDING PARTS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the current pay rate should be increased by five percent (5%) for all Employees including Police department employees; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hebron believes that it would be in the best interest of the Village to increase the pay rate in order to hire and retain well-trained and qualified personnel; and

WHEREAS, said pay rate increase shall be effective the first full pay period after the effective date of this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO, AND THE MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section I: The current pay rate for all employees shall be increased by five percent (5%) effective the first full pay period after the effective date of this ordinance.

Section II: All other ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended.
