ORDINANCE 03-22

AN ORDINANCE WHEREBY THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON AGREES TO ASSUME MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITY FOR U.S. ROUTE 40 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS NATIONAL ROAD ADJACENT TO THE AREAS PROPOSED TO BE ANNEXED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE BY LESLIE S. JOHNSON AGENT, AND THE PROPERTIES OWNED BY CRISS J. AND JOYCE LEE NADOLSON.

Whereas, Council has received notice of the filing of an Expedited II Annexation Petition for the annexation of ten (10) acres, more or less from Union Township to the Village of Hebron; and

Whereas, Licking County has an annexation policy requiring municipalities to adopt a Highway Responsibility Ordinance (HRO) regarding divided or segmented roadways adjacent to annexed properties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO, WITH A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1. That the Village of Hebron hereby agrees to assume maintenance responsibility for U.S. Route 40 otherwise known as National Road in the area adjacent to those areas of land proposed to be annexed into the Village of Hebron by Leslie S. Johnson, Agent. The approximate date that the Village will assume maintenance responsibilities for said roadways is the annexation's effective date.

Section 2. That the Village of Hebron has agreed to indemnify the State of Ohio, the public entity with jurisdiction as to the part U.S. Route 40 otherwise known as National Road that it shall be responsible to repair or maintain. Therefore, in consideration of the premises and other good and valuable considerations, the Village of Hebron hereby undertakes to indemnify and save the State of Ohio and their respective employees, agents, and assigns from and against any and all suits, claims or liabilities whatsoever which said State of Ohio may at any time sustain or incur by reason of, or in consequence of, injury or death to personal property arising from, or as a direct result of said Village's maintenance of or failure to properly maintain U.S. Route 40 otherwise known as National Road.

Section 3: That this Ordinance will take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
