#### **ORDINANCE NO. 04-20**

# AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN MUNICIPAL PROPERTY SURPLUS, NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR USE, AND AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF SAID PROPERTY VIA SEALED BIDS (PER ORC. §721.15(A)).

WHEREAS, the Village of Hebron has personal property no longer needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code 721.15 (A) permits the sale of personal property no longer needed for public use, by sealed bids; and

WHEREAS, the Hebron Village Council desires to sell its unneeded personal property by sealed bids;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON, LICKING COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

- Section I: The Village of Hebron will sell its unneeded personal property as described in the attached Exhibit "A", which is hereby incorporated by reference, in 2020 through sealed bids in accordance with the requirements of O.R.C. 721.15(A) & O.R.C. 7.16.
- Section II: The Village of Hebron will advertise twice, over the course of at least two weeks but not more than four weeks, for sealed bids in a newspaper of general circulation.
- Section III: The Village of Hebron will issue bidding rules and requirements which are described more fully in the attached Exhibit "B"
- Section IV: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon the earliest period allowed by law.
