ORDINANCE NO 08-20

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SHELLY COMPANY FOR THE MILLING AND RESURFACING OF MISCELLANEOUS ROADWAYS IN THE NEWARK INDUSTRIAL PARK AS SPECIFIED BY BID; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Hebron advertised for qualified companies to submit bid proposals for the Milling and Resurfacing of Miscellaneous Roadways in the Newark Industrial Park to include Capital Drive, Reliance Drive, the Village's part of John Alford Drive, and Integrity Drive, and;

WHEREAS, the Village Council has reviewed the bid applications for said Milling and Resurfacing of Miscellaneous Roadways contract, and;

WHEREAS, Shelly Company is the lowest and best bid received in accordance with the specifications upon which such bid was received, and;

WHEREAS, an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary to enter into a contract for the aforesaid services for the preservation of the public health and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO, AND TWO THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

<u>Section I</u>: The Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the Council of the Village of Hebron, to enter into an agreement with Shelly Company regarding the Milling and Resurfacing of Miscellaneous Roadway Improvements.

<u>Section II</u>: The compensation for said services shall be in accordance with specified bid amount attached hereto.

<u>Section III</u>: For the reasons stated in the Preamble hereto, which is made a part hereof; this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
