ORDINANCE 09-22

An ordinance indicating what services the Village of Hebron will provide to the property to be annexed as per the petition filed by Connie J. Klema, Agent for the Petitioners, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Hebron, Ohio, has received notice that Connie J. Klema, agent for petitioners has filed a for an Expedited Type II Annexation Petition for annexation for a 72-acre property; and


WHEREAS, the Village is required by Ohio Revised Code Section 709.023(C) to enact the following legislation, and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists for the preservation of the public welfare of the Village, and it is immediately necessary to enact this legislation within 20 days of the filing date per Ohio Revised Code Section 709.023(C)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO, WITH 2/3 OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1. If annexation is finally approved for the property involved in the petition filed by the above-named Petitioner, the Village will provide police protection services to said property, and the Village will assume the responsibility to maintain and repair all public streets adjacent to the area to be annexed.

Section 2: For the reasons stated in the Preamble hereto, which is made a part hereof; this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
