ORDINANCE NO 11-23

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 25-22 TO PROVIDE FOR ADJUSTMENTS OF THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2023 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Hebron desires to amend the 2023 Annual Appropriations Ordinance 25-22 as required by the Ohio Revised Code and the Licking County Auditor, and;

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has recommended appropriations to supplement previously made appropriations, creating the necessary funds to make the desired appropriations, and;

WHEREAS, the recommended appropriation changes are declared an emergency measure in order to provide for the daily operations of a municipal corporation, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO, AND TWO THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT: To provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of said Village of Hebron during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2023, the following changes are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:



Section I: That the Village of Hebron 2023 Annual Appropriations Ordinance 25-22 is hereby amended.

Section II: The following appropriations are hereby added in the General Fund and Fire Fund:

1000-740, 910 – General Fund
740-640 – Payment to Another Public Entity

910-910 – Transfers Out

Section III: Sums expected from the above appropriation which are proper charges against any other department or against any firm, person, or corporation, if repaid within the period covered by such appropriation, shall be considered re-appropriated for such

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original purposes, provided that the net total of the expenditures under any appropriation shall not exceed the original total.

Section IV:

The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payments from any of the foregoing appropriation changes upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by officers authorized by law to approve the same, or action of council to make the expenditures.

Section V:

This Ordinance therefore shall become effective immediately for the purpose of effecting expenditures within the limitations herein set forth, during the fiscal year extending from that date to December 31, 2023.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
