Ordinance No.13-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH WEST LICKING JOINT FIRE DISTRICT AND FOR THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON, OHIO TO BECOME PART OF SAID DISTRICT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Hebron and the Township of Union, Licking County, Ohio have jointly decided to withdraw from the Refugee-Canyon Fire District, and

WHEREAS, in light of the termination of Refugee-Canyon Fire District, the Village of Hebron has determined that the best option to provide fire/EMS services to its residents is to become part of the West Licking Joint Fire District, and

WHEREAS, concurrent with becoming part of the West Licking Joint Fire District, the Village of Hebron shall lease its fire station at 111 Basin St., Hebron, Ohio to the West Licking Joint Fire District and lease to West Licking Joint Fire District some vehicles and equipment it owns that will be returned to it by Refugee-Canyon Fire District.

WHEREAS, in light of the preservation of the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hebron, this matter is deemed an emergency.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON, OHIO, THAT:

Section I: The Mayor is authorized to do those acts necessary for the Village of Hebron, Ohio to become part of the West Licking Joint Fire District, so as to provide fire/EMS services to the residents of the Village of Hebron, and

Section II: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract for lease of the fire station and the lease of vehicles and equipment to West Licking Joint Fire District concurrent with the Village of Hebron becoming part of said district, and

Section III: This matter being deemed an emergency, it shall become effective at the earliest possible date as permitted by law.
