ORDINANCE 16-23

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY NOT NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE SAME BE SOLD TO ANOTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION WITHOUT BID (PER O.R.C. §735.053)

WHEREAS, the Village of Hebron, Ohio owns certain property, to wit, a 2015 Ford Explorer, VIN #1FM5K8AT2FGC07833, and

WHEREAS, said vehicle, which has a value of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00), is no longer needed for any municipal purpose, and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police with the concurrence of the Council deems it prudent to dispose of the same by sale, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hartford, Ohio hereby desires to purchase said vehicle, and

WHEREAS Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract, without advertising or bidding, with the Village of Hartford, Ohio for the sale of said vehicle; such sale shall be conducted in accordance with O.R.C. §735.053.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO BY A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The 2015 Ford Explorer, VIN #1FM5K8AT2FGC07833 is not needed for any municipal purpose and there is declared as surplus, and

Section 2: The same shall be sold in accordance with O.R.C. §735.053, to the Village of Hartford, Ohio for the sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00), and

Section 3: The Village hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract without advertising or bidding for the sale of said vehicle and to do such other acts as are necessary to affect the sale of said property.
