ORDINANCE NO 18-21

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH STRAWSER PAVING COMPANY FOR THE HOPE DRIVE ROADWAY AND WATERLINE EXTENSION; DENNISON EXTENSION WITH T-TURNAROUND; MILLING AND RESURFACING OF MISCELLANEOUS ROADWAYS AS SPECIFIED BY BID; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS the Village of Hebron advertised for qualified companies to submit bid proposals for the Hope Drive Roadway, Sidewalk and Waterline Extension; Dennison Street extension with T-Turnaround; Milling and Resurfacing of Miscellaneous Roadway to include Broad, Mound, 4th and 5th Streets along with Park Avenue, and;

WHEREAS, the Village Council has reviewed the bid applications for said Milling and Resurfacing of Miscellaneous Roadways contract, and;

WHEREAS, Strawser Paving Company is the lowest and best bid received in accordance with the specifications upon which such bid was received, and;

WHEREAS, an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary to enter into a contract for the aforesaid services for the preservation of the public health and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO, AND TWO THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section I: The Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the Council of the Village of Hebron, to enter into an agreement with Strawser Paving Company regarding the Hope Drive Roadway, Sidewalk and Waterline Extension; Dennison Street extension with T-Turnaround; Milling and Resurfacing of Miscellaneous Roadway to include: Broad, Mound, 4th and 5th Streets along with Park Avenue Roadway Improvements as specified by the bid.

Section II: The compensation for said services shall be in accordance with specified bid amount attached hereto.

Section III: For the reasons stated in the Preamble hereto, which is made a part hereof; this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
