Ordinance No. _____ ORDINANCE 27-22 Passed

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND A SECTION OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON, OHIO TITLED GENERAL SEWER USE REQUIREMENTS PURSUANT TO 933.02 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Hebron desires to increase efficiency in the Village and provide flexibility to modify the local limits of the current waste water system; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hebron desires to make these local limits easily accessible to the public via online access and the Village believes an amendment to 933.02(f) would be appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the Section 933.02(f) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Hebron, Ohio states, “[t]he following pollutant limits are established to protect against Pass Through and Interference. No person shall discharge wastewater containing in excess of the following Daily Maximum Limits”; and

WHEREAS, passage of this ordinance is an emergency and necessary to preserve the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hebron and Council believes this project should be enacted at the earliest possible date allowed by law and is in the best interest and well-being of the Village of Hebron; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO BY AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Section 933.02(f) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Hebron shall eliminate the table located therein and be amended to state as follows: “No person shall discharge wastewater containing parameters in excess of the current Local Limits. These limits are listed on the Village’s webpage for the Department of Water Reclamation and can be viewed at the Village Offices.”

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be declared an emergency and take effect at the earliest possible time allowed by law.
