ORDINANCE 30-22

AN ORDINANCE TO PERMIT AN INCREASE IN THE CURRENT PAY RATE BY 3% FOR ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON, TO AMEND CONTRARY AND INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES BY REPEALING AND AMENDING PARTS THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the current pay rate for all Village employees could be increased by 3% for Employees; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hebron believes that it would be in the best interest of the Village to increase the pay rate in order to hire and keep well-trained and qualified personnel; and

WHEREAS, said pay rate increase shall be effective the first full pay period after January 1, 2023.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO, AND THE MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section I: The current pay rate for all Village employees will be increased by 3%, effective the first full pay period after January 1, 2023.

Section II: All other ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended.

Section III: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force the first full pay period from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor and Village Council.
