ORDINANCE 19-21

AN ORDINANCE WHEREBY THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON, OHIO ACCEPTS THE RE-PLAT OF LOTS 282, 283, PART OF 284 OF CULLY'S ADDITION AND VACATED SECTION OF CHURCH STREET BETWEEN SOUTH STREET AND DEACON STREET.

WHEREAS, there has been presented to the Council a re-plat of Lots 282, 283, part of 284 Cully's Addition and a vacated section of Church Street between South Street and Deacon Street which constitutes a re-platting of an area previously platted; and


WHEREAS, this re-plat has been reviewed by the Council, Planning Commission, Engineer, Community Development Coordinator and Administration of this Village and the same has been found to be in conformance with the applicable subdivision regulations of the Village of Hebron, Ohio; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO, THE MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section I: That the re-plat of Lots 282, 283, part of 284 Cully's Addition and a vacated section of Church Street between South Street and Deacon Street as presented to this Council be and is hereby approved and accepted. A copy of the plat is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Section II: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
