## RESOLUTION NO. 20-02

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SHELLY COMPANY FOR SUPPLEMENTAL PAVING IN 2020, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Hebron, Ohio has previously entered into an agreement with The Shelly Company for paving related to Enterprise Drive; and

WHEREAS, recent engineering has revealed the necessity of full depth repairs on a portion of Enterprise Drive at an additional cost of Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00); and

WHEREAS, circumstances have arisen such that it is possible and prudent to engage The Shelly Company while on-site to complete additional paving in the Newark Ohio Industrial Park area; and

WHEREAS, the cost of such additional paving is estimated to be One Hundred Thirty-Eight Thousand, Eighty-Seven Dollars and Eighty-Two Cents (\$138,087.82).

WHEREAS, based upon timing and availability this resolution shall be deemed an emergency and it shall become effective upon passage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON, OHIO, AND TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

Section I: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with The Shelly company for supplemental paving in the Newark Ohio Industrial Park consisting of approximately 4623 linear feet of road surface for a total cost not to exceed Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000); and

Section II: The Village Administrator is authorized to expend up to an additional Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00) for full depth repairs on Enterprise Drive.

<u>Section III</u>: This resolution shall become effective upon passage.
