Resolution No. 20-04

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING A DISASTER DECLARATION RELATED TO RECENT WEATHER EVENTS, AND DECLARING THE SAME AS AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the weather events of March 19 and 20, 2020 and March 27, 2020 have resulted in flooding and damage throughout the Village of Hebron, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hebron hereby adopts a Disaster Declaration in order to encourage or facilitate access to state and federal disaster funds and programs, and

WHEREAS, the problems associated to this disaster pose a threat to and endanger the health, safety, and welfare of persons and property within the Village of Hebron, Ohio and as such this shall constitute an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON, OHIO, AND TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

Section I: The Council hereby adopts and ratifies the Disaster Declaration attached hereto and which is hereby incorporated by reference, and

Section II: In light of the emergency circumstances noted therein this legislation shall be effective immediately upon passage.


Disaster Declaration

WHEREAS, due to unprecedented rainfall that occurred on March 19, 2020 and March 20, 2020, which caused the South Fork of the Licking River to reach record levels due to of five (5) inches of rainfall within a twelve (12) hour period and subsequent rainfalls thereafter including March 27, 2020 resulting in flooding within the Village of Hebron causing thousands of people to lose power, severe property damage to homes and businesses, and the disruption of business and commerce, and

WHEREAS, the effects of the same endangered and continue to endanger the health, safety, and welfare of persons, as well as the property and financial welfare of persons, as well as the property and financial welfare of businesses when the Village of Hebron, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hebron requests that the Licking County Commissioners through the Licking County Emergency Management Agency declare Licking County a disaster area due to the flooding and related storm damage and that the Licking County Commissioners likewise request that the State of Ohio issue a disaster declaration for Licking County, Ohio in the hope of local residents, businesses, and governmental entities being able to access emergency funds and or other governmental benefits.

WHEREFORE, I, James Layton, Mayor of the Village of Hebron, Ohio do hereby declare a state of disaster within the Village of Hebron, Ohio.
