

RESOLUTION 20-11

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND / OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hebron is planning to extend Hope Drive and the 8" waterline to North High Street, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a critical need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and welfare of the Village,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY 2/3 OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON, LICKING COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section I: The Mayor of the Village of Hebron is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

Section II: The Mayor of the Village of Hebron is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section III: This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage.
