## RESOLUTION 21-03

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE STORMWATER COORDINATOR LINDA NICODEMUS, VILLAGE OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO TO SUBMIT THE NOTICE OF INTENT PERMIT ELECTRONICALLY PERTAINING TO THE SMALL MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEMS (MS4S) - GENERAL PERMIT, FACILITY PERMIT NUMBER: 4GQ10011\*DG AS REQUIRED BY THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, the Ohio Environmental protection Agency requires the Village of Hebron, State of Ohio to submit a Notice of Intent as a co-permittee to the Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4s) - General Permit renewal for Licking County and Others, and;

Whereas, the Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4s) - General Permit renewal is due July 1, 2021.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by two-thirds of the members elected thereof concurring that; the Council of the Village of Hebron, State of Ohio


**Section 1:** The Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4s) - General Permit has an effective date of April 1, 2021, and an expiration date of March 31, 2026.

**Section 2:** As a co-permittee of the Licking County and Others permit the Storm Water Coordinator Linda Nicodemus will actively manage the OEPA electronic reports and permits on behalf of the Village of Hebron, State of Ohio

**Section 3:** The Village of Hebron, State of Ohio will submit the Notice of Intent to participate with the Licking County and Others MS4 permit to be in compliance with the requirements mandated by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, State of Ohio, prior to July 1, 2021

Section 4: This Resolution shall be effective at the earliest date permitted by law.
