ORDINANCE 21-23

An ordinance to accept the application for an Expedited Type II Annexation for certain property into the Village of Hebron, Ohio from Union Township, pursuant to the petition filed by Connie Klema, Agent for Petitioner.

Whereas, the Licking County Commissioners have on June 22, 2023 adopted a Resolution accepting the petition for an Expedited Type II Annexation from Union Township to the Village of Hebron, Ohio certain territory, adjacent and contiguous, containing twenty-one and forty-three one hundredths (21.43) acres, more or less, and so entered in Commissioners Journal No. 119 page 258; and

Whereas, by Ohio Revised Code 709.04 required the Village to accept or reject the petition after the expiration of sixty (60) days from the date of delivery to the Village of the certified copy of the entire record of the annexation proceedings; and

Whereas, the Commissioners granted the Expedited II Annexation on June 22, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO, WITH A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: That the petition for Expedited Type II Annexation for certain contiguous territory from Union Township to the Village of Hebron, as filed by Connie Klema, Agent for Petitioner, containing twenty-one and forty-three one hundredths (21.43), more or less, as more clearly defined in the petition thereof, is hereby accepted.

Section 2: That this Ordinance will take effect and be in full force at the earliest time allowed by law.
