RESOLUTION 22-10

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE LICKING COUNTY AUDITOR AND LICKING COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION TO NOT LEVY OR OTHERWISE TO COLLECT THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON EXISTING FIRE LEVIES AT ZERO (0) MILLS FOR THE ENSUING FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS, the electors of the Village of Hebron, Ohio previously approved two fire levies – a continuing 4.0 mills levy and a 2.0 mills levy, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hebron, Ohio intends to join or become part of the West Licking Joint Fire District to secure fire/EMS services for its citizens, and

WHEREAS, once the Village of Hebron, Ohio becomes a part of the West Licking Joint Fire District, it shall automatically become subject to said districts millage to fund the fire/EMS services, and

WHEREAS, in light of being subject to the West Licking Fire District millage, it would be duplicitious to likewise levy or collect the Village's fire/EMS levy funds, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON, OHIO THAT:

Section I: That the Village of Hebron, Ohio hereby certifies to the Licking County Auditor and the Licking County Budget Commission that the Village's fire/EMS levy will not be needed in light of Village of Hebron, Ohio residents being subject to the West Licking Joint Fire District millage which will fund fire/EMS services, and

Section II: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village of Hebron hereby requests that the Licking County Budget Commission, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §5705.341, finds the revenue generated by the existing levies will not be required for the Village's budget purposes, and requests that the Commission take the appropriate action to not levy, or to otherwise collect the fire/EMS levies at zero (0) mills for the ensuing fiscal year only, and

Section III: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Licking County Auditor without further order from the Village of Hebron, Ohio.
