RESOLUTION NO 22-12

A RESOLUTION INCREASING THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON'S REAL PROPERTY TAX RATE BY .8 MILLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the Village Council's attention that the Village of Hebron has inside millage available to increase the real property tax rate without voter approval; and

WHEREAS, Village Council has determined that it is necessary to increase said inside millage by .8 mills; and

WHEREAS, Council believes increase of millage is necessary for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Hebron and should be enacted at the earliest possible date allowed by law for the express purpose of meeting the deadline requirements set by Licking County Budget Commission; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO THAT THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON HEREBY ADOPTS AND APPROVES A .8 MILL INCREASE WITH TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:


Section 1: The Village Council of Hebron, Ohio approves and adopts a .8 mill increase to the Village of Hebron's real property tax rate.


Section 2: The Clerk of this Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Licking County Budget Commission for the express purpose of increasing the inside millage rate by .8 mills.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 4: This resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the reason that the same is necessary for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Hebron, the Council of the Village of Hebron having voted by a two-thirds majority to dispense with a full and distinct reading of this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon the signature of the Mayor and shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
