## RESOLUTION 23-11

A RESOLUTION NOTIFYING THE LICKING COUNTY AUDITOR AND LICKING COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION OF THE TERMINATION OF DUPLICATIVE FIRE LEVIES IMPOSED ON THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON.

WHEREAS, the electors of the Village of Hebron previously approved fire levies – a continuing 4.0 mills levy and a 2.0 mills levy, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hebron, Ohio has joined or become a part of the West Licking Joint Fire District to secure fire and emergency medical services (EMS) services for its citizens, and

WHEREAS, as a result of joining the West Licking Joint Fire District it has become subject to said district's millage to fund fire/EMS services; and

WHEREAS, in light of joining the West Licking Joint Fire District it is duplicative for the Village to likewise levy or collect the Village's fire/EMS levy funds; and

WHEREAS, the Licking County Budget Commission has notified the Village of Hebron, that the continuing 4.0 mills levy and the 2.0 mills levy has been removed or terminated from the Village's levy schedules due to passage of Village Resolution 23-09 and as a result the levies will not be imposed on Village residents; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO BY A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

**Section 1:** The Village of Hebron, Ohio hereby certifies to the Licking County Auditor and the Licking County Budget Commission that the Village's fire/EMS levy is not necessary, and the millage obtained from said levies is duplicative and excessive as a result of the Village of Hebron, Ohio joining the West Licking Joint Fire District, and


**Section 2:** The Village of Hebron, Ohio hereby notifies Licking County Auditor and the Licking County Budget Commission that it is terminating the Village of Hebron's fire/EMS levies pursuant to § 5705.19(AAA)(5) of the Ohio Revised Code, and

**Section 3:** The Village of Hebron, Ohio hereby directs the Village Fiscal Officer to file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Licking County Auditor without further order from the Village of Hebron, Ohio.
