RESOLUTION 24-02

A RESOLUTION INDICATING WHAT SERVICES THE VILLAGE OF HEBRON WILL PROVIDE TO THE PROPERTY TO BE ANNEXED AS PER THE PETITION FILED BY ELIZABETH SEEDORF, AGENT FOR THE PETITIONERS.

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Hebron, Ohio, has received notice that Elizabeth Seedorf agent for petitioners has filed a for an Expedited Type II Annexation Petition for annexation; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section O.R.C. § 709.023(C) requires that a municipal corporation shall, by ordinance or resolution, adopt a statement indicating what services, if any, the municipal corporation will provide to the territory sought to be annexed and an approximate date by which it will provide them; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Hebron finds that the general good of the territory sought to be annexed will be served by its annexation to the Village of Hebron and that the territory is not unreasonably large to be annexed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF HEBRON, STATE OF OHIO, WITH A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: That if annexation is finally approved for the property involved in the petition filed by the above-named Petitioner, the Village will provide the following services:

- A. The services of a full-time Village administrative staff, including but not limited to a Village Administrator, a Village Clerk of Council, a Village Fiscal Officer, a Village Economic Development Director, among others.
- B. The services of a full-time Village Police Department including but not limited to road and traffic patrol, radar detail, complaint investigations, accident investigations, and other duties.
- C. Fire and emergency medical services shall be provided by the West Licking Joint Fire District pursuant to Village Resolution No. 13-22 which authorized the Mayor of the Village of Hebron to contract with the West Licking Joint Fire District to provide Fire and EMS services to the Village.
- D. The services of a full-time wastewater collection and treatment department and a full-time water treatment and distribution department. The Village has the capacity and will be able to provide services at such time as the lines are extended to the territory. The extension of water and sewer lines may be subject to special assessments of other public financing and may be the responsibility of the party requiring such an expansion.

Section 2: Except as otherwise noted above, the services listed will be provided to the territory immediately upon the effective date of annexation. Nothing in this Resolution shall preclude the Village from providing additional services as needed and as available.

Section 3: The Clerk of the Village Council is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Board of County Commissioners of Licking County.

RECORD OF RESOLUTIONS

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Section 4: This Resolution shall be effective from and after the date of its passage and will take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowable by law.
